Located in the heart of the Portes du Soleil ski area and with 650km of ski slopes, it is no wonder that this resort has been a popular choice among skiers of all abilities.

If you are not a dedicated skier or boarder, fear not, as there will be plenty to do, including icediving, nature tours, snowmobiling, snowshoeing and shopping. There is also a world-class ice rink and a large swimming pool.

Though there won't be an educational programme for this trip – we all need time off once in a while – we will suggest an evening programme which is entirely optional and last but not least, our first ski trip closing dinner.

Website is currently under construction, and we are looking at opening registration on the 31st October. So make sure you keep an eye out through the usual means: Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn.

Flights, accommodation, transfers, catering (breakfast, afternoon tea and evening 3 course meal) are included from the UK – Non-UK attendees are requested to book their own flights separately (a discount will apply to the total cost of the trip for this reason) – nearest airport is Geneva. We will be able to recommended suitable transfer companies.

Option 1:

Accommodation only from 24 to 31 January. Half board at Hotel Renardiere in Morzine. £488 per person based on 2 sharing (approximately €680)

Option 2:

Option 1 plus return flights and transfers from Gatwick Airport, London £558 per person.

Option 3:

Accommodation only from 28 to 31 January. Half board at Hotel Ridge in Morzine. £401 per person based on 2 sharing (approximately €560). This also includes a local ski pass.

<u>Insurance</u>

Please note that insurance is not within the above prices. Insurance, to include winter sports, has to be taken out by the individuals.

Invite your significant others, invite your colleagues, and anyone else you feel like (whether they are lawyers or non-lawyers it is irrelevant; though little piece of advice for non-lawyers, if you can't ski, you must be able to party like a lawyer).
